



BEAUBLANC STADIUM

Limoges, France

Beaublanc Stadium is the historic football and rugby stadium of the city of Limoges. It is located in the city center, within an exceptional landscape setting, in a large Sports Park. The project aims to completely rebuild the stadium on its current site, in 3 phases, while remaining operational, to create a new iconic 20,000-seat stadium.

Beaublanc Stadium: A Urban Stadium at the Heart of an Exceptional Sports Park Landscape

Beaublanc Stadium is integrated into the heart of a large 19-hectare Urban Sports Park, which also includes a Sports Palace, a swimming pool, an athletics stadium, and six football and rugby playing fields. The Sports Park, also a public park, is open to the public during the day, allowing for a coexistence between high-level sports and spontaneous, amateur sports activities.

To preserve this unique feature, a true added value for the local community, we designed the stadium with controlled access and new attractive spaces along its façade. The open public plazas surrounding the stadium contribute to the daily life of the Sports Park, as do the spaces dedicated to the football club on the West façade, and the restaurant on the South façade, in alignment with the main entrance of the Beaublanc Park.

We have developed a comprehensive master plan for the sports park to ensure the simultaneous operation of the new stadium alongside other sports facilities. The new stadium thus encourages sports practice by allowing interactions between (...)
